The People Hive is committed to creating and supporting real opportunities for adults with learning difficulties living within the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames and surrounding areas. Volunteers are crucial. Your help is going to be vital to our success and will be greatly appreciated. Due to the nature of the charity, all volunteers must be aged 18 or over.

You can help us in different ways:

1. **Client Activities:** we offer a large range of affordable activities for our clients. Volunteers supporting these activities are sent a two monthly programme, and they can choose which upcoming activities they would like to be involved in.
2. **The Gallery:** our shop showcases and sells local artists' and crafters' work. The charity receives a commission from each sale, which enables us to carry out our important work. Our volunteers do a 3 hour shift in the gallery (11-2 or 2-5, Monday to Saturday).
